

She was born in Denizli in 1996. She started playing piano when she was 7. In 2006 she was accepted into Çukurova University State Conservatory. By the time she started high school, she had studied piano with Çağla Çoker for 4 years. At high school she continued her studies with Can Çoker. She skipped 3rd year in high school. In 2011 she took Honorable Mention at the Pera Piano Competition. Afterwards she was admitted to study at the Hacettepe University Ankara State Conservatory as a student of Sanem Berkalp.

In 2016-2017 she was an Erasmus student at Detmold Hochschule für Musik in Germany. There she studied with Prof. Hartmut Schneider. In the same year she was graduated from bachelor with honors.

In February 2018 she was accepted to Staatliche Hochschule für Musik und Darstellende Kunst Stuttgart and Hochschule für Musik Carl Maria von Weber Dresden as a master student. Since winter semester 2018 she has been studying at HMDK Stuttgart as a master student of Prof. Peter Nagy.

During her education she was awarded the first prize with her piano duo partner Melis Ertürk, with whom she has been playing for three years, at the **2nd International Competition Villafranca VR City and Les Musicales du Centre Paris International Music Competition**; “Honorable Mention with very good results“ at “**The 4. Rising Stars Grand Prix 2019 International Music Competition** in Berlin. The duo gives regular performances in Germany and Turkey as piano duo “Umuda Sesler”. She also took second prize at the competition, that is in Villafranca (Italy) in solo category.

Throughout her education she appeared in lots of concerts, including chamber music concerts. She has participated in masterclasses of Ayşegül Sarıca, Emre Elivar, Muhittin Dürrüoğlu, Gülsin Onay, Jonathan Plowright, Peter Nagy and Hans-Peter Stenzl, Volker Stenzl.

She has been continuing her education as a scholarship holder of Dr. Nejat F. Eczacıbaşı and Türkiye Çağdaş Yaşamı Destleme Vakfı.
